- Enter all of the information needed for your request. Do not use short forms or abbreviations.

• Fill in a separate submission for each item required.

Workflow Before the Update

- Multiple manual steps
- Human error possible in every step



OCUL library receives email with request information

OCUL library searches for item in Alma OCUL library fills out the lending request in Alma using info from email

Request now appears in Alma

Failure Points

- Requester can enter incorrect details
- Email can be missed
- Shipping the wrong copy
- Copy and paste mistakes
- Takes too long!

Workflow After the Update

- Uses an API
- Creates request right in Alma
- Uses MMSID to automatically match bibliographic record
- Takes 5 15 seconds!



Chart of the lending request workflow after update

Failure Points Solved

Requester can type incorrect details

Correct item is automatically attached to lending request.

• Email can be missed

Request shows up right in Alma.

• Shipping the wrong copy

Uses MMSID to attach requested copy.

Copy and paste mistakes

Automatically fills out lending request in Alma with submitted information.

Takes too long

Takes 5 – 15 seconds.

Exceptions

API needs valid MMSID and partner code

- If no/invalid MMSID, request appears in Alma as "Locate Failed"
- If API fails, send an email
